

Palos Verdes High School Class of 2008 Profile & College Summary

The Class of 2008 represented the 4th graduating class since the school re-opened in 2002-03. In the 2007-08 academic year, the total enrollment was 1860 students.

The Class of 2008 consisted of 445 students.

College Acceptance and Matriculation

98% of the Class of 2008 went on to attend over 114 different colleges in 30 states and the District of Columbia.

Three students chose to study abroad.

They were accepted to 226 different colleges, including all University of California and California State University campuses. A total of 22 students were accepted to an Ivy League school, seven out of eight member institutions.
